 - Achieve NMS in literacy and numeracy for their year level or
 - Have an evidenced based learning plan in place to address their specific learning needs
- Increase the % of Yr.3 students in the U2B in reading from 11% (2013) to 30%
- Increase the % of Yr.5 students in the U2B in reading from 6% (2013) to 30%
- Increase the % of Prep students achieving PM Level 9 in reading from 15% (2013) to 50 %
- Increase the % of Yr.1 students achieving PM Level 19 in reading from 36% (2013) to 60 %
- Increase the % of Yr.2 students achieving PM Level 25 in reading from 42% (2013) to 70 %
- Increase the overall attendance rate from 82.7% (2014) to 89%

Our strategy will be to

- Implement Foundational Learning Programs (Reading Mastery & Phonemic Awareness)
- Monitor student reading and numeracy performance data (2 to 5 weeks) to review the effectiveness of targeted teaching programs, provide students with supportive feedback and to reorganize instructional groups (Ellis & Worthington 1994 – Principles of effective instruction)
- Implement PSS Attendance System and embed processes and strategies school wide
- Develop & implement school-wide Response to Intervention System
- Develop the capacity of teachers in the explicit and systematic teaching of reading (Ofsted Reading by six)
